Common PCE Violations and Security Issues

Common Palm Cove Estates Violations:

(These will result in a letter from the HOA)

These include anything that violates the covenants or renders your property unsightly and detracts from the beauty and value of the neighborhood. Most common violations are:

- Items visible from the street Hose carts, trash cans, bags, debris and other things of that nature.
- Unkempt lawn, shrubs and palm trees. Grass needs mowed, re-sodded etc. Dead branches
- Fence in need of repair
- Roof, sidewalk and driveway are moldy, dirty or contain algae, needs to be pressure washed
- Trashcans and or yard waste are to be placed at the curb any time after 5 PM the night before pick-up and put away the day of the pick-up by 7 PM. Yard waste cannot be put out days before pick-up.

Orange County Code Violations:

(These can result in a warning or ticket from Orange County)

- Car parked on the street directly opposite a driveway
- Walking your dog without a leash, dog left to roam
- Dog left out in the hot sun
- Dog barking for long period of time
- People not cleaning up after their dog (This is a health issue too)
- Throwing anything down the sewer drains
- Vans or trucks parked on the street longer than 48 hours
- Vehicles parked across sidewalks causing pedestrians to have to walk on the street
- Vehicles parked in the wrong direction

Common Security Issues:

(These can result in a burglary or advertising that our neighborhood is vulnerable)

- Leaving your garage door open
- Not locking your car or leaving valuable items in the car visible to thieves
- Obvious signs that you are not home
- Overgrown shrubs
- Being unaware and not mindful of strangers in the neighborhood
- Encouraging solicitors
